State Wage Reopener Approved by Civil Service Commission

The Civil Service Commission voted to approve the negotiated wage agreements at their December 13, 2023 meeting. The 5% base wage increase will be effective October 1, 2024. The additional ratification bonus of \$2,250 will be paid as soon as "administratively feasible" in calendar year 2024.

This completes the final year for the current Collective Bargaining Agreement expiring on December 31, 2024. All three state employee units will begin negotiations for a new contract this summer. We thank the bargaining teams for their work on this wage reopener. Bargaining surveys for the next full contract will be sent out in the Spring.

Local 517M Committee Appointments—Will You Serve?

Member engagement is the engine of our UNION. The more members that are engaged, the more powerful and visible we are. Did you know your Union has several standing and special committees you can join? We are currently recruiting new members to come and join us as we get ready for 2024. All appointments will expire at the end of the President Comb's term on December 31, 2024. All committee members are open for reappointment by the next President at that time.

The following standing committees currently have positions available:

<u>Election/Tally Committee:</u> Oversees the general elections of the Local and shall be responsible for nominations and the preparation, tallying and certification of general election ballots. Members who are not running for a leadership position that the Committee would count are eligible for appointment.



Ethics Committee: Works with the ethics liaison to review and maintain the SEIU Code of Ethical Practices and Conflict of Interest Policy, approved by the International Executive Board. This Committee is responsible for educating all members, officers, and staff on these codes and practices.

<u>Member Engagement Committee:</u> Promotes membership in the Union, "Members-Only" benefits, and initiate organizing activity for, and on behalf of, the Union.

<u>Political/Legislative Committee:</u> Oversees and promotes the Union's political and legislative programs, as well as promote member involvement in the Committee on Political Education (COPE).



The following special committees currently have positions available:

<u>New Member Orientation and Sign Up:</u> Membership is the fuel that runs our UNION. The Committee helps individual units with member to member outreach in new hire orientations.

<u>Community Partnership Committee:</u> Focuses on opportunities for members to partner with community allies and others with a common goal. The committee works to build solidarity with other unions, organizations and neighbors to unite and advance our vision. As we continually find ways to increase our public visibility as advocates for quality public services, we will need community partners!

Leadership Development: Leaders are the drivers of our UNION. The Leadership Development Committee is responsible for facilitating the Leadership Academy. The Academy is comprised of various modules of 4-hour sessions, which are spread over 4 Saturdays which will be inperson and on Zoom. The participants are fellow members who apply for the Leadership Academy and are selected based on certain criteria.



Article 13, Section 3 of the SEIU Local 517M By-Laws states:

Standing Committee Members shall serve until discharged by the President, or until the conclusion of the President's term. Special Committee Members shall serve for the term of the committee as established upon committee assignment. Any Committee Member may resign upon written notice to the President.

SEIU 517M - Tomorrow's Michigan Today Scholarship is open to dues-paying members in good standing (as defined in the SEIU Local 517M Constitution and Bylaws), their spouse, children, step children, adopted children or grandchildren with college or trade school expenses.

There are 15 scholarships available and the amount of each scholarship is \$600. These non-renewable scholarships will be awarded to students based on

successful completion of the application process and meeting certain criteria. Awards will be made via a lottery system from all eligible submissions.

Applications will be available starting in February, 2024.
