## **SEIU Local 517M Constitution and Bylaws**

## Article 10, Section 2 – Eligibility for Officers, Executive Board Members, and Divisional Board Members

A. Eligibility. Candidates for Officers and Executive Board members shall be accepted by the Election/Tally Committee according to the Bylaws. This Committee shall review and report candidates to the Secretary/Treasurer of the Union. All candidates shall have been a member of the Union for at least twelve (12) continuous months preceding the election ballot count date. State employees also need to have reauthorized their dues for the next fiscal year.

B. Disqualifications. No person who has been convicted of a felony as defined in Section 504 of the Landrum-Griffin Act (or an indictable offense in Canada) shall, in accordance with the provisions of applicable law, be eligible to hold office in this Local Union. No candidate (including a prospective candidate) for any office in this Local Union or affiliated body, or supporter of a candidate may solicit or accept financial support or any other direct or indirect support of any kind from any non-member of Service Employees International Union.
