

<u>2025 Rules and Conditions of the SEIU 517M -</u> <u>Tomorrow's Michigan Today Scholarship Award Program</u>

15 - \$600 non-renewable scholarships will be awarded each year to students based on successful completion of the application process and meeting of the criteria stated below. Awards will be made via a lottery system from all eligible submissions to Tomorrow's Michigan Today.

Students are given a choice of which semester/term to apply the award to. This selection must be made on the initial application.

Applicant Eligibility:

- The Scholarship is open to any member, spouse, child, grandchild, stepchild, or adopted child of an SEIU Local 517M member in good standing as defined by the SEIU Local 517M Constitution and Bylaws.
- Applicants must have graduated from any high school (or equivalent) and be enrolled as a student in an accredited college, university, community college, or trade school as a freshman; or be returning to an accredited college, university, community college, or trade school as a sophomore, junior or senior as of the Winter or Fall of 2025.

Application Instructions:

- Complete all sections of this application.
- On a separate piece of paper, submit a brief essay of no less than 500 words outlining your current educational goals and what you hope to achieve after graduation. Possible topics to discuss in your essay could include your major and minor (if applicable), any internships, and what you plan to accomplish with your education.
- Incomplete applications, or failure to include any portion of the application, will disqualify you from consideration.

General Information:

- Winning a scholarship award from SEIU 517M Tomorrow's Michigan Today Scholarship Program
 does not guarantee entrance to a trade school, college or university.
- Tomorrow's Michigan Today Board will annually review the number and dollar amount of scholarships offered.
- All matters pertaining to this scholarship awards program will be handled by the Tomorrow's Michigan Today Board.
- Scholarships are awarded without regard to gender, race, religion, sexual orientation, disability, or political affiliation of the applicant.
- Scholarships are limited to one per household for each academic year.

Winter Semester/Term 2025 (January - May 2025) Recipients Must Complete the Following Steps:

- Students must submit a receipt of expenses incurred from Winter semester 2025 from the accredited college, university, community college, or trade school they are currently enrolled in. There are no restrictions as to the curriculum a student may follow.
- Submit a transcript from Winter semester 2025 from an accredited college, university, community college they are currently enrolled in showing academic good standing or a trade school letter of academic good progress.
- Courses must be completed for that semester without a break. No incomplete courses are accepted.
- Receipt and transcript (or letter of academic good progress) need to be received no later than 30 days after the end of the Fall semester.
- ◆ Payment will be made from the SEIU 517M Tomorrow's Michigan Today, 501(c)3 in Fall, 2025.

Fall Semester/Term (August - December 2025) Recipients Must Complete the Following Steps:

- Students must submit a receipt of expenses incurred from Fall semester 2025 from the accredited college, university, community college, or trade school they are currently enrolled in. There are no restrictions as to the curriculum a student may follow.
- Submit a transcript from Fall semester 2025 from an accredited college, university, community college they are currently enrolled in showing academic good standing or a trade school letter of academic good progress.
- Courses must be completed for that semester without a break. No incomplete courses are accepted.
- Receipt and transcript (or letter of academic good progress) need to be received no later than 30 days after the end of the Fall semester.
- ◆ Payment will be made from the SEIU 517M Tomorrow's Michigan Today, 501(c)3 in January, 2026.
